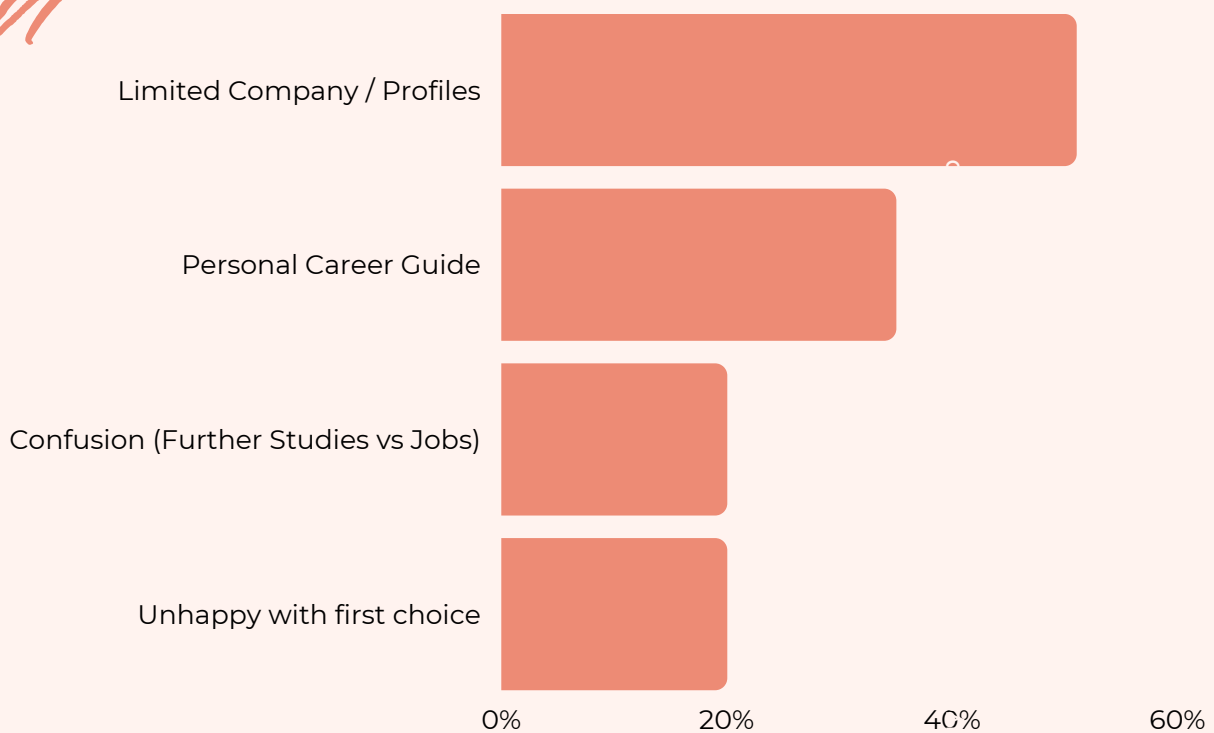
# CAREER DILEMMAS

Whether we are a student, entry level or even a seasoned professional we all tend to be faced with multiple choices more often than not. Here's some quick insights on what's been troubling some of us!

## AT CROSSROADS

When quizzed on key issues faced during their most recent placement process, we learnt that students seek individual attention during their placement process so that they don't just settle for the first opportunity that comes by or remain endlessly confused about whether they want to pursue higher studies or join the workforce.

## THE OBSTACLE COURSE

For those who changed their jobs recently, some of the key obstacles faced were:

45% of respondents found it difficult to switch careers to a different industry / function

39% of respondents found it difficult to level up & apply to senior roles / land promotions

But, the most interesting insight is...

Only a mere 29% of respondents thought their interviewing skills were a problem! While a much higher percentage (~40%) found it difficult to get their resumes shortlisted..

Is awareness the problem?

From our initial set of responses, it makes us wonder: since getting resumes shortlisted seems to be the bigger problem, is that why interviewing skills are not considered as much of a hindrance?
